FIELD MEETING TO LATHKILL DALE

Date: 29th May.
Time: 11.0 a.m.
Place: Over Haddon.

Surface Party: Surveying the course of the Lathkilldale Sough and taking levels at the Sough Tail and shafts along it, levelling at the Mandale Sough Tail, plumbing the depth of various shafts and the depth to the water level where possible.

Underground Party: It was hoped to arrange a trip into Lathkill Dale Sough to work in conjunction with the surface party, but owing to the recent heavy rain this sough will definitely be inaccessible.

It is suggested therefore that the underground party spend the day investigating the numerous small shafts and levels in the Dale in order to help to build up a general picture of the area. Rough surveys could be made and certainly water levels, water temperatures etc. can be recorded. Photography will be useful to the private collector but photographs will also be taken for the Society collection.

This is an ideal opportunity for both groups to work in close liaison and to make a start on the considerable amount of work to be done in the area, and it is hoped that as many members as possible will attend.
